Description: This art class is designed specifically for the younger elementary student that loves to create! Our creations will burst with spring colors as we use paints, glues, colored papers and more. Story books or interesting facts may also be used to motivate and inspire young artist. Student interaction is encouraged and show & tell times are often offered in this social and fun class. All art materials will be supplied. Students need to be at least 6 years of age by 9/09 to participate in this class.

What to bring: Nothing, all materials will be provided.

Syllabus: Note: This is an approximate order of projects to be attempted. Some students may work quicker and others longer, with most projects averaging 2+ weeks to completion. A few projects from each student will be saved for display and then returned at the end of the spring program.

Project #1 Valentine card pockets

Projects #2 Finger paint a large design, dry, then trace and cut out a spring themed design. Glue to colored paper and add yarn design for detail.

Project #3 Fish - Draw a fish, outline with black glue, color with oil pastel, paint a blue watercolor wash over all. Frame.

Project # 4 Easter stained glass - make a stained glass effect work of art using tissue paper, wax paper, modge podge and black construction paper.

Project # 5 Self portrait- cut & glue a full body self portrait from plain and patterned construction paper.

Project # 6 Butterfly - Study and draw a favorite specie of butterfly. Transfer the drawing to a ceramic tile, paint with acrylics.
